Executive Summary

This task entitled 7.2 A Study of Public-Private Partnerships (PPPs) entails a careful analysis of existing models and other relevant innovative collaboration models (ICMs) that operate in the healthcare space. This report involves the study of joint ownership, organizational models, codes of conduct, policies and workflows that can be leveraged within EPAD. Special attention is devoted to sister initiatives that can represent useful paradigms and potentially opportunities for a partnership with EPAD. In addition to such companion initiatives, the study will examine other life sciences models focusing on open innovation and will include a critical assessment of their benefits and limitations as it pertains to EPAD.
